

The sports provision at Knutton St Mary's is already considerable. Pupils are able to take part in a range of activities which include:

- professional sports coaching
- swimming lessons at KS2,

- After school activities in kick boxing, gymnastics, fencing and multisports.
- Participation in School Games competitions against other local primary schools.

In addition to these activities the school will be participating in a range of sporting activities over the next academic year. The aim of these activities is to promote healthy lifestyles and physical wellbeing in all pupils, encourage a lifelong love of sports and to challenge and stimulate learning for both pupils and staff within our school.
